
Calculus book project – point value descriptions

1 pt: Very little included for topic. Might give definition and an example, but missing most of listed material for topic and very little to no explanations. Could also have incorrect material given.

2 pts: States most of what is listed for the topic but might be missing a couple parts. Doesn't explain – gives definition and examples without much else.

3 pts: Includes everything listed (or missing VERY minor part) but not thorough in explanations or the explanations are confusing. States the information versus explaining it. Gives some examples, but not enough to adequately show all types. Very few graphs or visuals are included (when applicable).

4 pts: Very thorough in explanations and examples. Easy to follow and understand. Includes EVERYTHING listed for topic AND explains – doesn't just state what was listed. Gives examples of all different types of problems/situations. Includes good graphs and/or visuals when applicable.

5 pts: Everything from (4 pts) but goes above and beyond with explanations, additional examples, and/or visuals. Makes you think "Wow, this is amazing!!"
